	I, the undersigned, being a Government Officer of Japan or a veterinarian accredited to provide export certification on behalf of the Government Veterinary Service of Japan, certify with respect to the bovine meat products identified in this Official Meat-Inspection Certificate for Bovine Meat that:		
	I. Commodity eligibility Fresh bovine (domestic cattle) bone-in and/or deboned meat (chilled and frozen) and products derived from these, excluding offal and central nervous tissue. II. Processing, packaging, and storage requirements (1) The bovine meat was processed in premises that operate <i>Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) and Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP)</i> programmes to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority and that are approved for export to New Zealand, and: – the bovine meat was derived from animals that passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection, and is eligible to enter the human food chain. (2) To the best of my knowledge, the bovine meat was commercially packaged and sealed in clean, secure, contaminant-free and leakproof packaging at the time of manufacture, and has been stored and subsequently transported in a hygienic manner that prevents contamination and deterioration of the product. (3) The consignments; – will be transported directly from Japan to New Zealand by air freight; or – the container in which the bovine meat for export will be transported has been sealed under Competent Authority supervision and the unique seal number is recorded on this certificate. III. Specified requirements for identified risk organisms (1) The bovine meat is derived from bovine animals that have been born, reared, slaughtered and processed in Japan. (2) Japan is free from FMD and FMD vaccination is not practiced. (3) Japan is free from <i>Brucella abortus</i>, <i>B. melitensis</i> and <i>B. suis</i> in bovine animals. (4) The bovine meat was derived from animals: – From establishments that are not under quarantine restrictions for anthrax, and where no case of anthrax has occurred in the 20 days prior to slaughter, and – Not vaccinated against anthrax with a live vaccine within 14 days prior to slaughter, or a longer period in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. (5) The bovine meat does not contain offal. (6) The bovine meat does not contain central nervous tissue. (7) Japan is a country posing negligible BSE risk, and a ban on the feeding of ruminants with meat-and-bone meal and greaves derived from ruminants has been effectively enforced since October 2001.
