

Organic Equivalency Arrangements currently in place with the Organic JAS System
(as of April, 2026)

1. Organic Products covered under the scope of the Equivalency Arrangements with Australia, Canada, The United Kingdom and The European Union as follows:
 - ① Organic Products of Plant Origin,
 - ② Organic Livestock Products
 - ③ Organic Processed Foods including alcohol beverages

2. Organic Products covered under the scope of the Equivalency Arrangements with Switzerland and the United States of America are as follows:
 - ① Organic Products of Plant Origin,
 - ② Organic Livestock Products
 - ③ Organic Processed Foods

3. Organic Products covered under the scope of the Equivalency Arrangements with New Zealand is as follows;
 - ① Organic Products of Plant Origin
 - ② Organic Processed Foods of Plant Origin including alcohol beverages

4. Organic Products covered under the scope of the Equivalency Arrangements with Argentina are as follows;
 - ① Organic Products of Plant Origin
 - ② Organic Processed Foods of Plant Origin

5. The member states of the European Union:
Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherland, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain and Sweden

6. Organic Products covered under the scope of the Equivalency Arrangements with Taiwan※ is as follows;
 - ① Organic Products of Plant Origin
 - ② Organic Processed Foods of Plant Origin including alcohol beverages

※In accordance with the private sector arrangements agreed between The Japan-Taiwan

Exchange Association and The Taiwan-Japan Relations Association, competent authorities of both Japan and Taiwan have recognized each other's organic system as being equivalent, where organic products certified to the Taiwanese organic agricultural product system or the Organic JAS system may be treated as organic in both Taiwan and Japan.
