
# Direct Payments for Hilly and Mountainous Areas in Japan

# Purpose of the policy

Hilly and mountainous areas protect the property and lifestyles of numerous people living in the lower reaches, through the multifunctionality of agriculture and rural environments. (flood prevention, watershed protection etc.)

Because of the natural, economic and social disadvantages, hilly and mountainous areas are facing increased abandoned farmland, depopulation and aging.

## Direct Payment System has been introduced since FY2000.

Payments to <u>fill the gap of production costs between hilly and mountainous areas</u> and <u>flat areas</u> to make the farming in hilly and mountainous areas sustainable.


### Basic mechanism

# 1 Targeted Areas

Designated areas under eight less favored area development laws (the Mountainous Area Development Law, the Peninsula Development Law, the Remote Island Development Law etc.) or other areas designated by prefectural governors.

# 2 Targeted Farmland

Any contiguous farmland 1 ha or more in size that satisfies any of the criteria shown below.



#### Other criteria include:

- · Paddy field on small plot or with irregular shape
- ·Farmland located in community with high aged population share or high cultivation abandonment rate
- ·Grassland with lower cumulative temperature and higher grassland ratio

## 3 Required activities

## Basic Activities Basic rate (80% of system development rate)

Agricultural production activities for at least five consecutive years.

Community agreement concerning the management policy of farmland, roads and water channels.

# System development Activities System development rate

#### Activities relating to productivity/revenue improvement

- ·Communalization of machinery and farm work
- ·Implementation of high added-value farming
- · Processing and marketing of locally produced crops, etc.

#### Activities relating to fostering of farming individuals and entities

- · Recruitment of new farmers
- · Fostering of certified farmers
- ·Concentration of farmland in the hands of principal farmers
- ·Outsourcing of farm work to principal farmers

#### Activities relating to the realization of multifunctionality

- ·Interaction with urban residents and others through the utilization of the health and recreational function
- ·Coordination with school education, etc. with regard to the conservation of nature s ecosystems
- ·Collaboration with nonfarm households, other communities, etc. towards the continued realization of multifaceted functions
